	Set-Up/Recover Troop Entry Way w/ Troop 477 banner / sign attached. Troop and US Flags Posted at camp Entry Way.					
	Fill troop water containers (if not already filled). Leave near handwashing station.					
	If required, Dig and Setup Troop Latrine. Fill and Cover Latrine on Departure.					
	Set-up Troop First Aid Station on Main Kitchen Easy Up.					
	Dig grease pit for kitchen / cooking fluids. Fill and cover on departure.					
ALL	Set-Up Patrol Kitchen area, Table and Lanterns. Set patrol boxes in appropriate kitchen area.					
ALL	Set-up Patrol Fly, Patrol Flags, Water Container(s) and Track Container(s). Fill Water Container(s).					
ALL	Prepare Saturday Breakfast					
ALL	Clean-Up After Breakfast (Kitchen, utencils & trash in patrol area)

	Gather Firewood for Evening Campfire. Set up Campfire. Fill fire buckets w/ Water. Ensure that fire is properly extinguished.						
	Prepare Skit or Song for Evening Campfire.						
ALL	Clean-up after dinner. (Kitchen, Cooking utencils & trash in patrol area)						<b>ALL Scouts in Patrol</b>
ALL	Check Kitchen and Patrol Area with Scouts Responsible for Clean-Up. Make Corrections as needed.						Patrol Leader / Asst Ptl Ldr
	Ensure Trash Containers and food are properly stored for evening - Nothing Left Out that you don't want animals getting into.						
	Prepare Sunday Breakfast						
	Clean-Up After Breakfast (Kitchen, utencils & trash in patrol area)						
	Check Kitchen and Patrol Area with Scouts Responsible for Clean-Up. Make Corrections as needed.						Patrol Leader / Asst Ptl Ldr
ALL	Take Down Kitchen and Table. Store Lanterns in Lantern Boxes. Take to rear of trailer.						
ALL	Recover all remaining Patrol Equipment and ensure it is clean. Take equipment to rear of trailer.						
ALL	Secure and close all trash containers to rear of trailer (leave one trash container open for final camp trash pickup).						
	Provide one Scout as Loadmaster for trailer (Patrol Quartermaster if present).						
	Provide one Scout as Loader for trailer.						

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ALL	Participate in Troop Campsite Police Line Under Direction of SPL							All (Exc. Trailer Loadmstr.)
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Patrol Set-Up Checklist

- (1) Kitchen Setup
- (2) Dining Fly Setup (no drooping centers)
- (3) Drinking Water Container(s) Filled
- (4) 3 Wash Buckets Present
- (5) Lantern Setup
- (6) Trash Container(s) in Patrol Area
- (7) Table Setup
- (8) Duty Roster Completed and Posted in kitchen area
- (9) Menu Posted to kitchen
- (10) Patrol Members are informed of their assigned duties.

<u>Extra items for Camporess</u>	
	(1) Tarp under every tend and tarp completely under tent.
	(2) Every tent staked down.
	(3) One Fire bucket for Each tent
	(4) All items picked up around tents. Tent flaps shut when scouts are not in camp.
	(5) Place warning tape on tent guy lines.
	(6) If it is dirty and in your patrol area, clean it!!
